Special Bible Study beginning Sunday, May 6th

I'm excited to announce a new summer-only Sunday School option! For 12 weeks, I will be teaching a class about the Daniel. There is no book, but over 12 Sundays we will be reading the entire book of Daniel and discussing how God is at work in Daniel's life despite his exile to Babylon.
