Sunrise Service at Kentucky Dam on Sunday, August 26, 2018

Kentucky Dam was completed and its gates closed on August 30, 1944, and its first generator went online September 14, 1944. The project cost nearly \$118 million, making it the most expensive TVA dam project. Kentucky Dam's navigation lock was the first lock designed by TVA.

Everyone is welcome to join us at the Dam for a sunrise service in celebration of the first Dam Day that took place 74 years ago.
