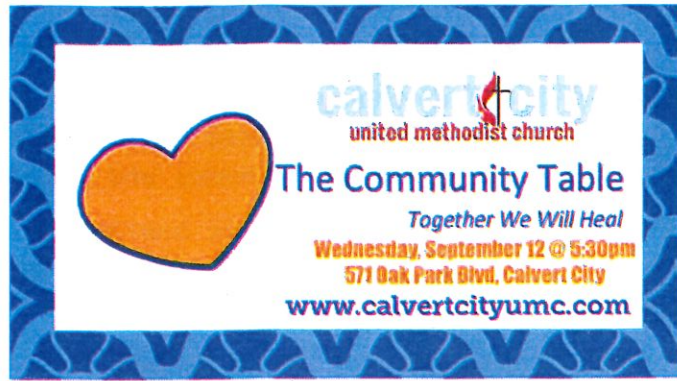

**“Live Well – Emotional Wellness Gatherings”  
Depression Help Class**



*Sponsored by the United Methodist Churches of Marshall County*

Live Well is a wellness ministry of Church of the Resurrection UMC in Leawood, Kansas. This 6-week session is designed to educate participants about depression while giving simple steps to relieve symptoms. There is no cost for this program. We believe that if we can get the science right, we can get the care right. Live Well offers a variety of support and education for those struggling with depression.

Group sizes are limited and classes are closed following the second week.

At Church of the Resurrection, roughly 90% of the people who attended these classes that combine biology and spirituality have experienced a noticeable improvement in their symptoms.

We pray that people find support and improvement in their symptoms in the “Live Well – Emotional Wellness Gatherings” we are starting here in Western Kentucky as well following the Curriculum from Church of the Resurrection based on Dr. Stephen Ilardi’s teachings and therapeutic life changes from “The Depression Cure”.
