Please Note the Time Change: The Administrative Council will be meeting today at [4:30pm. All members, please make every effort to attend this important meeting.

In late February our Memphis Conference representatives-Eddie Bromley, Sky McCracken, Elyse Bell, and David Reed-will gather with almost 1000 other delegates from across the Methodist world to discern "Our Way Forward" about important matters concerning same sex marriage and the ordination of gay and lesbian neighbors. For more than four decades we Methodists have been in conversation about LGBTQ Christians and their place in the Christian community. Most of the other mainline denominations have had these same conversations among themselves. The special United Methodist called General Conference arises out of these repeated conversations in hopes to settle matters in ways that keeps us all together and faithful to God. We will also have a church wide conversation about this on Sunday, February 17 at 2:30 pm when we can talk further about these matters before us with leadership from our Superintendent and nearby retired ministers. With these conversations and conferences, we are living out another unique feature of our Methodist faith tradition—that when trusted neighbors come together in good faith and talk about important matters with deep hearts, we can count on God and God's way forward to show up and to become clear. Let us pray that this discernment process happens in all these deliberations and votes.
