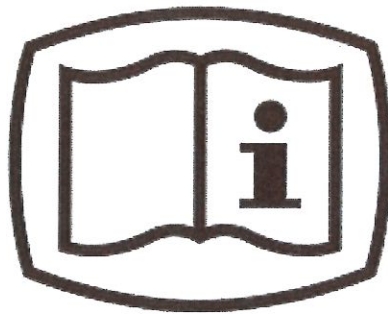

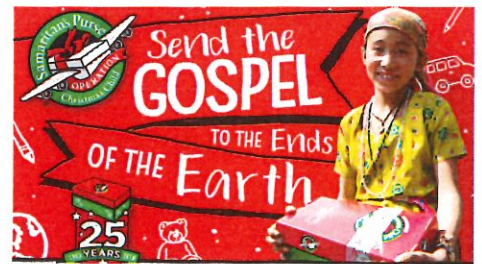
**Operation Christmas Child
