Building Committee Timeline

The Building committee has been hard at work trying to develop new space for our church mission and ministries as successfully as it was done in the move to this spot in 1991. We have tried to match design with function with cost. We have found a great partner in Pinnacle Construction Company. Watch for much more information set to arrive November 12 with many opportunities to see the possibilities and to ask every question as well as get some numbers on the cost of each phase of any construction for which we vote. We will come to your home to share the details of the plan if that will help it be clear. December 9 is our target for a church-wide vote to proceed in developing this plan and organizing a financial campaign to underride the costs.
