A Lot to Talk About—Memphis Conference Merger

The Memphis and Tennessee Conferences are moving towards a new Conference together sometime in the next few years. As details of the new conference are emerging, many folks in the KY portion of the Memphis Conference have raised some special concerns that need to be considered as this new Conference is considered. The state line is a significant barrier to modern life with all its state-wide emphases on credentialing and taxation and incentives for higher education at state universities and colleges. Sometimes the state line has kept preachers from serving in west KY and conversely in west TN. To add to the conversations about the new Conference developing, our Bishop, Superintendents from both Conferences, preachers and lay folks from many other churches here in West KY are meeting here at Calvert City on Sunday afternoon February 10, 2:30 pm. All are welcome to join in the conversations or to hear many of our church leaders listen to neighbors practiced in considering multi-state organizations and speak about all the considerations and accommodations that are possible as the Conference boundaries take a new shape. One of the options could be to align Western KY with the Kentucky Conference though many other possibilities will be considered. Join in the conferring on this important matter.
